RESOLUTION NO. 3

WHEREAS, the Court of Appeals advertised the Invitation to Bid for the Supply and Delivery of Two (2) Units Vehicle VAN TCI MT 12-Seater (Lot 1) and Eight (8) Units SUV 4x2 G A/T DSL (Lot 2) for the official use of Ten (10) Associates Justices of the Court with an approved budget of P1,400,000.00 per unit or a total P14,000,000.00 in the Philippine Business Daily Mirror, PhilGEPS, Court Website and in conspicuous places in the Court compound on February 19, 2016;

WHEREAS, not one contractor responded to said advertisement, none purchased bid documents nor filed bid proposals for the aforementioned units, hence, the Committee declared a failure of bidding and recommended to Presiding Justice Andres B. Reyes, Jr. the re-posting of the Invitation to Bid in the PhilGEPS, Court website and in conspicuous places in the Court Compound.

WHEREAS, Presiding Justice Andres B. Reyes, Jr., approved the Committee's recommendation such that said Invitation to Bid was re-posted on on March 22, 2016 and as a result of which Toyota Pasong Tamo, Inc, purchased bid documents for Lot 2 and submitted its bid proposal on April 18, 2016 while none bought bid documents nor filed bid proposal for Lot 1;

WHEREAS, at 2:30 o'clock in the afternoon of the same date, the bid proposal submitted by the above-mentioned contractor was opened. It passed the eligibility and technical requirements so that its financial proposal was opened. For eight (8) units SUV 4x2 G A/T DSL, its bid proposal was P1,400,000.00 per unit or a total of P11,200,000.00;

WHEREAS, the Technical Committee evaluated the bid proposal submitted by said contractor and found it to be responsive.

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2016, the Committee conducted the post-qualification of the aforesaid contractor with its representatives, Ms. Glenda Campanero and Mr. Michael Rivera, who assured the Committee that if awarded the contract the units will be available for delivery. They were notified to submit the post-qualification documents such as PhilGEPS Registration Certificate and Income and Business Tax Returns which they complied promptly;

WHEREAS, after careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements, the Committee found Toyota Pasong Tamo, Inc. to have passed post-qualification;

WHEREFORE, the Committee Declared Toyota Pasong Tamo, Inc. the winning bidder for the Supply and Delivery of Eight (8) units vehicles, SUV 4x2 G A/T DSL and Resolved to Recommend to Presiding Justice Andres B. Reyes, Jr. to award the contract to it, for it offered the price most advantageous to the government at the same time Declared a Failure of Bidding for the supply and delivery of two (2) units VAN TCI MT 12-Seater and Resolved to Recommend to Presiding Justice Andres B. Reyes, Jr. to enter into negotiated procurement for the Supply and Delivery of aforesaid vehicles.
